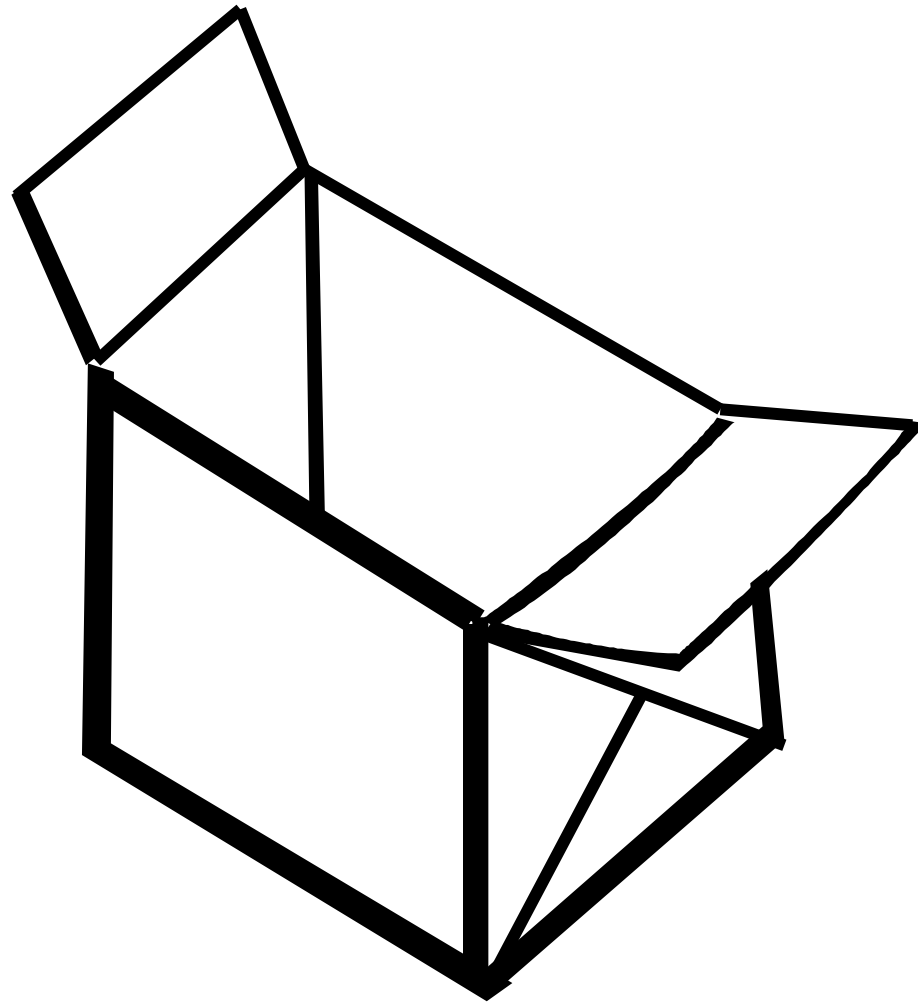
Contents Of This Package

Detailed Instructions #1

- Tear a 8.5" x 11" paper in half to get your raw material of **5.5" x 8.5"**. Save other half for later use.
- Fold for 3 long creases. **Make 3 even panels.**
- Fold for 3 short creases. **Make 3 even panels.**
- Match corner fold lines. **Crease outside diagonals.**
- **Fold all 4 outside diagonals** across short edge of cup.
- **Fold excess on top ends** over outside edge of cup.
- **Ta Da!—Yes! We've got a sign painters cup!**

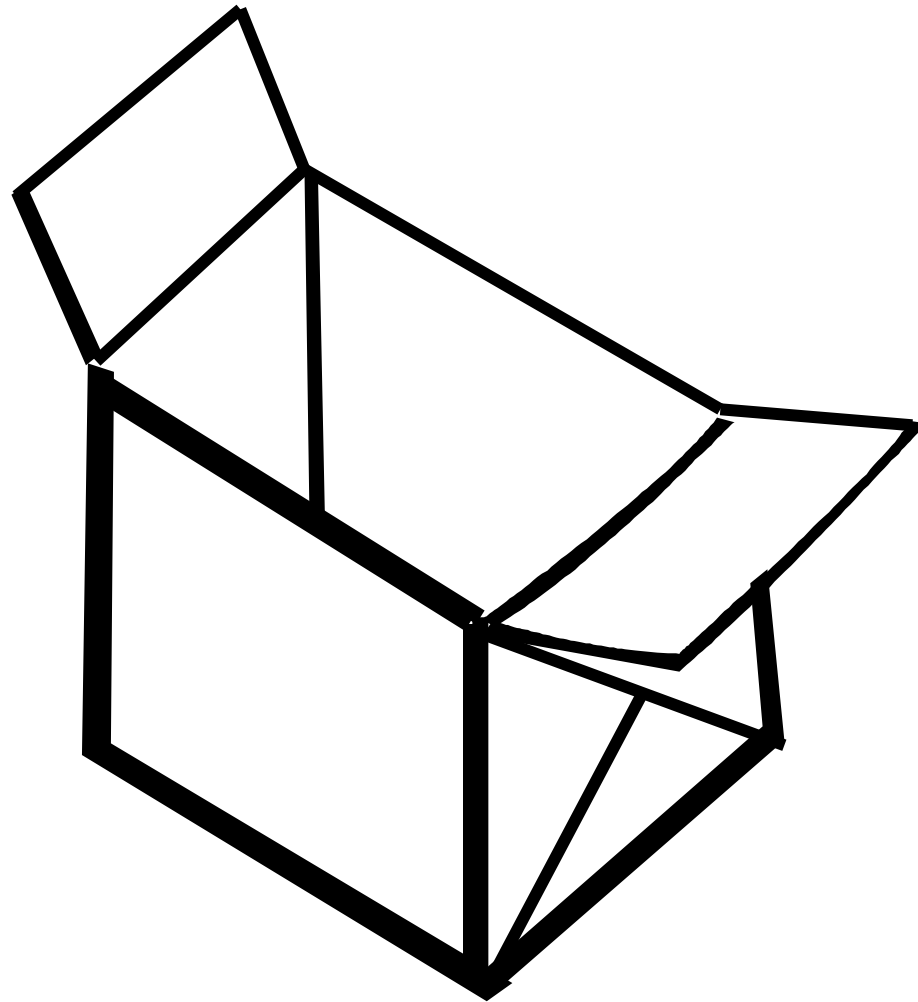
Here's A Sign Painters Cup It Looks Just Like Yours!



Detailed Instructions #2

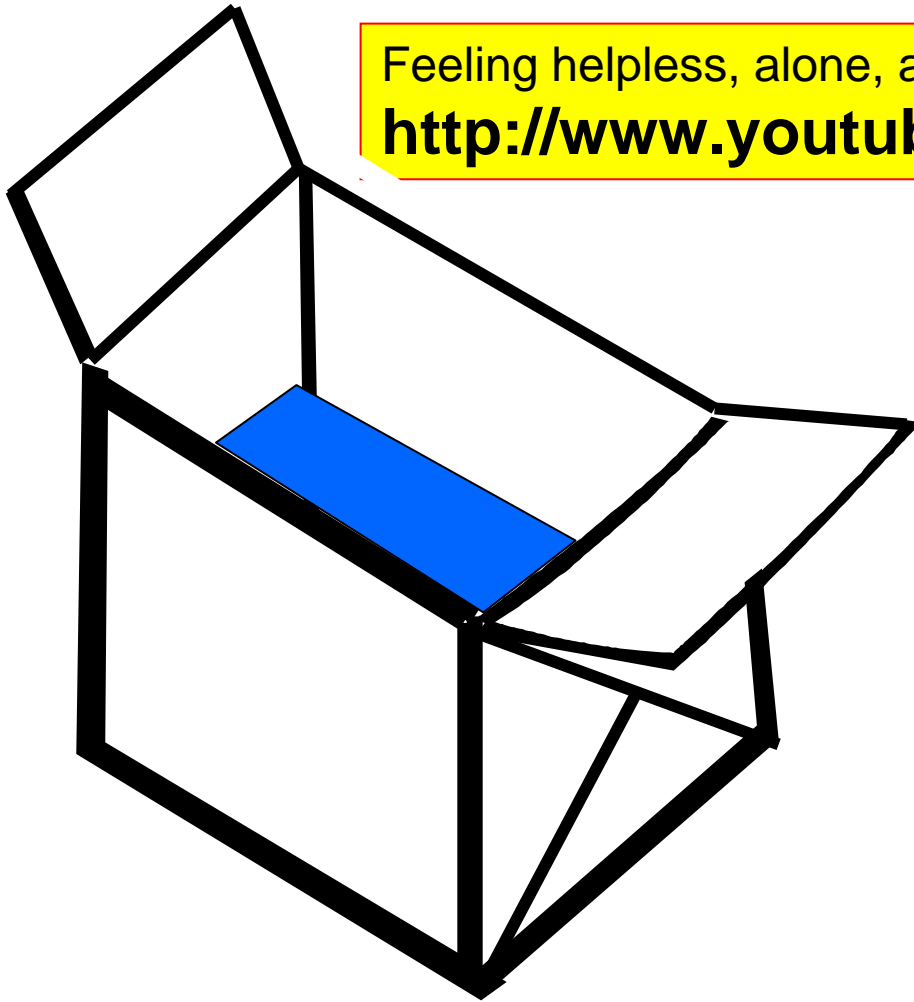


Detailed Instructions #3
